

How to join an International Committee?

The member has several ways to join an IC :

For new ICOM members :

➔ **When they fill in the application form to join ICOM.**

In this case, the affiliation will be imported in IRIS database at the same time than all their information.

For ICOM members:

➔ **Through IRIS memberspace.**


All the ICOM members have access to IRIS memberspace. (please note that, in general, the username is the email address).

The members can at least join or update their IC and their email through their memberspace. They can access to the IRIS memberspace here :

If the members cannot log in, this is certainly because their email is incorrect in IRIS. In this case thank you to update the email in IRIS. Once the information is up to date, the members user will be their email, and they will be able to use the link "*Forgot your password*" to reactivate their memberspace. If your NC does not use IRIS, thank to send the correct email to your membership coordinator in Paris, and ask for a reactivation of their IRIS accounts.

Once the members are connected, they can update their IC via the "*Edit my personal information*" button :



NB: In the case your NC is not using IRIS as database, please don't forget to update your NC's database.


